Following are requests for information received and RTA's response:

- Q1. Thank you for the PDF drawings of the wash bay areas. However, these drawings are not CAD drawings and therefore they cannot be scaled for dimensions. Do you have CAD drawings of the areas in question including, all architectural, structural, plumbing, process piping, and electrical? If so please forward to create a file which is responsible for the scope of this project.
- A1. See the attached CAD drawing files as requested. For the 601 building, the attached CAD drawing is all that is available.
- Q2. Will a bid bond, performance and payment bond be required for this project?
- A2. Yes, as stated below.

Bid Security

As security for the acceptance of a contract, each bid must be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check, or bid bond in the amount of **10%** of the total bid amount drawn payable to the Greater Dayton Regional Transit Authority (RTA). Such bid deposits of all bidders will be held by RTA until all bids submitted shall have been canvassed and the bids have either been rejected or the contract has been awarded. The bid deposit of the successful bidder will be held until the contract is duly executed. Bid deposits will be returned to the unsuccessful bidder(s) as soon as possible after award of the contract. The successful bidder under this bid shall execute a contract with the RTA, or its authorized representative, within ten (10) calendar days after notification of the award. If the successful bidder with whom the contract shall have been awarded refuses to execute the contract within ten (10) calendar days after notification of award of the contract, the amount of the bid deposit shall be forfeited to and retained by RTA as liquidated damages for such neglect or refusal.

Performance Bond

The successful bidder shall furnish, at its own expense, a performance bond in the percentage/amount stipulated on the Bid Form within ten (10) calendar days after notification of award, as a guarantee of good faith on behalf of the contractor that the terms of the specifications will be complied with in every particular. The performance bond shall, on its face, reference the date(s) of the contract period and the material, equipment or service covered by the contract. This bond shall be guaranteed by a surety company licensed to do business in the State of Ohio. The performance bond shall be conditioned on the complete performance of the contract, in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code Section 306.43. The RTA will not agree to release the surety on a performance bond until at least sixty (60) days after the acceptance of the **Bus Wash Systems**, to be provided under the contract, and the RTA reserves the right to require the surety to remain bound thereafter to the extent that the RTA may reasonably deem it necessary to do so to protect itself from the possibility of defective goods and/or services.

The due date for proposals is July 11, 2017 at 2:00 p.m.

This Addendum No. 3 shall become a part of the contract document and scope of work and shall be taken into consideration when preparing your proposal; you are hereby notified accordingly.
